WHAT THE NUMBERS MEAN:

Under 2.0 - Low test. It's difficult to get radon levels lower than this.

2.0 to 3.9 - Marginal test. The EPA recommends having a long term test performed to get a better sense of the overall seasonal average of radon in the home. There are typically no negotiations that take place at this point during a real estate transaction. If a long term test is performed and the results are still between 2.0 and 3.9, the EPA recommends considering mitigation.

4.0 or above - High test. Steps should be taken to lower radon levels in the home. The most common way of lowering radon levels is to have a radon mitigation system installed. Contact a qualified radon mitigation specialist to help with this.
